Audition Information:

All students who wish to audition for Show Band must be prepared to perform the excerpt listed, as well as sight read in their audition. All Show Band auditions will occur after school. Auditions will take place on **May 13th and 14th from 6-8:00 PM in the LHS Band and Jazz Rooms**. We will be happy to work with students who are currently involved with school spring sports. Be sure to focus on appropriate stylistic interpretation of your prepared pieces.

Show Band Audition Form:

Auditionees must complete the online form prior to their audition, as well as provide a current print-out of their grades and a recent photo. These are REQUIRED for both returning and new members!

Rehearsal Expectations

1. Be on time for every rehearsal
2. Cell phones are to be silenced and not permitted on stage at any time without permission.
3. No talking during the rehearsals unless you have raised your hand and have been acknowledged by the Directors.
4. Respect is to be shown at every rehearsal towards your peers, Directors, parent volunteers, and equipment.
5. No food or gum permitted on the stage at any time.
6. Capped water is permitted on the stage.
7. You are required to have your music folder and all necessary parts of your instrument at every rehearsal.
8. You may not leave the rehearsal area without the permission of the director.

All Show Band rehearsals will be held at LHS unless otherwise noted on the web site. Rehearsal times are, but not limited to, Monday and Thursday night from 6-8 PM. These rehearsals are a crucial to your placement within the group. Failure to attend could result in removal from some numbers and/or the entire show.

Competition Expectations:

The Show Band will be a part of many competitions this season. You are expected to be respectable representatives of the Loveland Show Choirs and Loveland High School. Below are some essential guidelines that will be expected when we are at competitions.

1. Be respectful of other groups at all times.
2. Do not talk about other groups at the competition.
3. You may not leave a school building without the permission of a director.
4. You may not have cell-phones out during performances. (After first occurrence, cell-phones will be left in homerooms.)
5. We will sit in the same general area when watching other groups.
6. Proper dress code will be followed when not in performance attire.
7. You must always have a buddy when walking around, you never walk anywhere alone.
8. Public displays of affection are not permitted at any time.
9. Students must not have an attitude when talking to director.

Travel Expectations:

1. Students are expected to follow the Loveland High School Code of Conduct.
2. Trip participants are expected to show respect for others and their belongings.
3. Parents will be contacted if discipline problems occur.
4. If a discipline problem is severe, the student will be sent home at the expense of the parent.
5. It is important that all instructions are followed at all of our destinations.
6. Students are expected to cooperate and be respectful of chaperones throughout the trip.
7. Participants are expected to be prompt at all meals and departures.
8. Everyone will be responsible for their own luggage and personal items.
9. All movies on the bus must meet the director's approval. Movies will be limited to PG or Pg-13 movies approved by the administration.
10. Students are reminded to be patient and flexible.
11. There will be no tolerance for violations of the drug and alcohol policy.
12. Parents are expected to be prompt when picking up their child. Any student who is still waiting after 20 minutes may lose traveling rights or bus for the next trip.

Hotel Guidelines:

1. Students are to follow room assignments throughout the trip.
2. Students must be in their room by the "Room Check". Times for Room Check will vary and will be announced each evening by the director.
3. At no time will any member be permitted in a room that they were not assigned. This includes same-gender rooms. This is a serious offense and will not be taken lightly.
4. All Hotel property is to remain in rooms. Rooms will be inspected prior to check-out. Occupants will be assessed for damages.
5. Students who make phone calls will be responsible to pay for all corresponding charges.
6. Students are not permitted to leave their rooms at night.
7. You must move around the hotel quietly in respect for other guests and always with a buddy. You never walk around alone.
8. Doors will be opened for Directors only.

Breaking the above rules may result in loss of traveling privileges or even removal from the group.

Internet Usage:

Many Show Choir members are active on the internet. You may not post any video or audio on the internet without the permission of Mr. Miller. You may not post any negative remarks towards other groups identifying yourself as a Loveland Show Choir member.

Member Conflicts:

Member conflicts should be resolved by the members involved. In the extreme case that the conflict affects the group, the director will step in to help resolve the issue. If the issue cannot be resolved, both members will be suspended until a resolution can be met. If **you** become the center of drama in the group, **you** will be asked to leave.

Parent Communication:

Parents may feel free to communicate with any of the directors. If you have a question or concern, we will do our best to assist with the situation at hand. We do not guarantee that things will always work out in the way that you wish, but we will do what is best for the group. Please be respectful when talking to and emailing show choir staff. This is an extracurricular/co-curricular activity, so most of the staff members are essentially volunteers.

Attendance:

Attendance at school and rehearsals are important to the success of the group. Students are expected to be at school in order to maintain performance eligibility. Students who miss rehearsals during the week of a show may be subbed out for that week. All absence requests should be communicated as soon as possible via email to Mr. Miller (millershowchoir@gmail.com) and the Show Band Directors. Please refrain from last-minute communication, as this will hinder the performance of the group.

Parent/Student Meeting:

An informational meeting for all students accepted into the Show Choirs and Show Band will be held on **Monday, May 20th at 7:00 PM in the LHS auditorium**. Parents are encouraged to attend. The meeting will cover pertinent information for the upcoming season, as well as provide answers to any questions you may have
